The Australian Plants Society NSW Ltd (originally called The Society for Growing Australian Plants NSW or SGAP) was established in 1957 by a group of people who "pledged to promote the establishment and breeding of Australian native plants for the garden, park and farm". By 1958 active regional groups had been established in six states and the ACT with a federal council (ANPSA) being formed in 1962.

Since that time the Society has continued to grow and expand its activities and in New South Wales alone has around 1600 members within District Groups operating throughout the region.

The activities of the Society are wide-ranging and include special interest Study Groups and the support of research through the Australian Flora Foundation.

It has been responsible for the establishment and the maintenance of public native gardens, parks and reserves throughout Australia.
